NICENE CREED

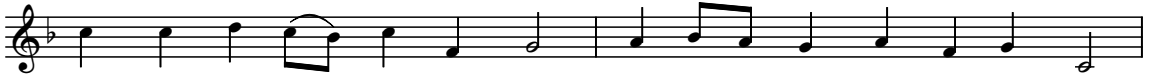
